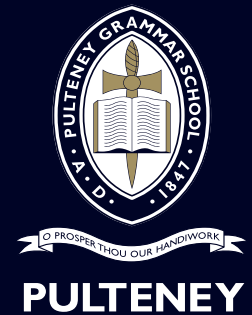

I am delighted to share with you Pulteney Grammar School's 2019 Year 12 results. These results reflect the dedication and perseverance of our students over many years at Pulteney.

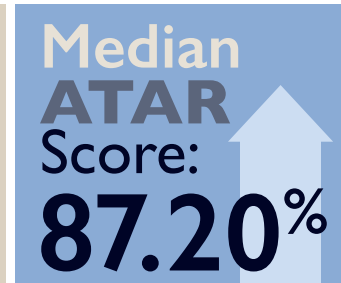
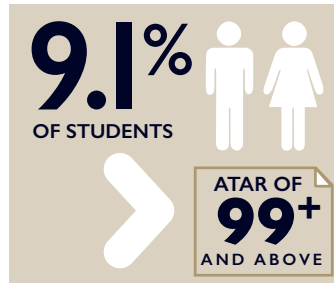
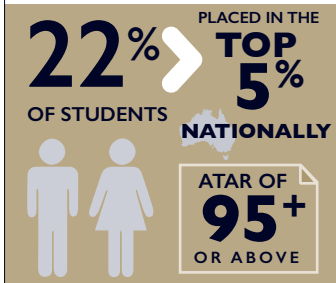
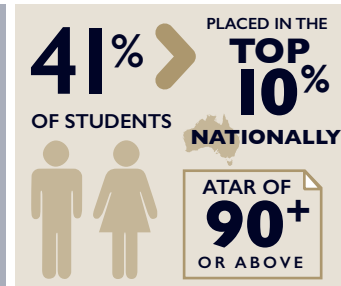
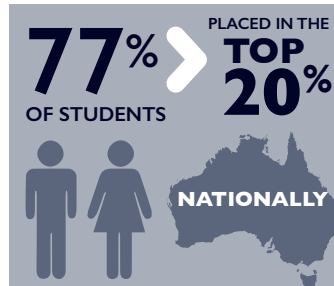

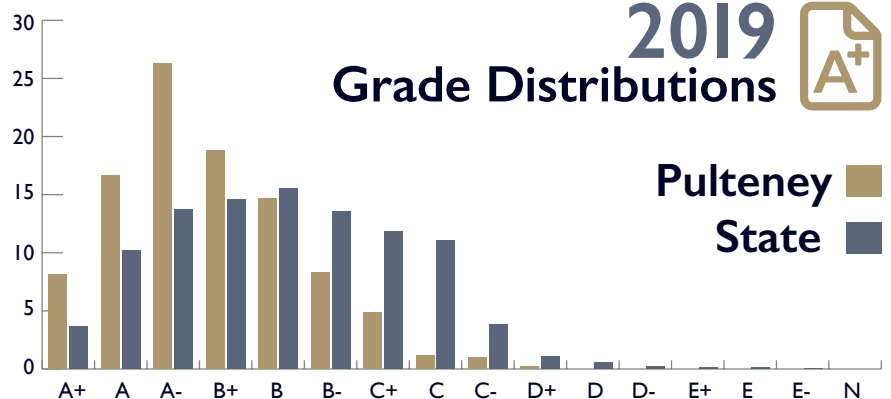
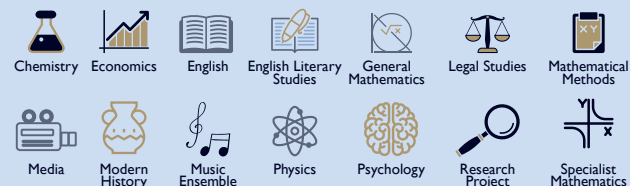
We recognise that our students are more than the sum of their academic results and are confident they enter the next stage of their lives well prepared to take on challenges with confidence, compassion and maturity.
